**Shirrel Road, Holytown**

**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2016**

On 14 November 2016 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on manhole replacement works) on Shirrel Road, Holytown from the its junction with Stevenson Street, eastwards to the extended line of the western kerb of Windsor Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the east side of the closure should proceed northwards on B799 Stevenson Street, north eastwards on A775 Main Street, south eastwards on St Andrews Street, south westwards, south eastwards, north eastwards then southwards on Sunnyside Crescent, south westwards on Dornoch Road then north westwards on Shirrel Road to the east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to travel to the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times, where applicable.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, by arrangement with the contractor.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Saturday, 3 December 2016 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 16 December 2016.

**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2016**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Shirrel Road, Holytown) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2016” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Saturday, the third day of December, Two thousand and sixteen until 2359 hours on Friday, the sixteenth day of December, Two thousand and sixteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on manhole replacement works) on Shirrel Road, Holytown from the its junction with Stevenson Street, eastwards to the extended line of the western kerb of Windsor Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the east side of the closure should proceed northwards on B799 Stevenson Street, north eastwards on A775 Main Street, south eastwards on St Andrews Street, south westwards, south eastwards, north eastwards then southwards on Sunnyside Crescent, south westwards on Dornoch Road then north westwards on Shirrel Road to the east side of the closure.*
