(Garrion Bridge, Wishaw)

(30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2002

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Garrion Bridge, Wishaw) (30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2002" and shall come into operation on the first day of July, Two thousand and two.

2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding thirty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

30 MPH Speed Limit

- (i) **A71 Horsley Brae**
From the extended north-west kerblineline of the existing Garrion Bridge, north-eastwards for a distance of 175 metres, measured along the north-west kerblineline of Horsley Brae.

- (ii) **New Road and both Bridges**
From the boundary with South Lanarkshire on the existing Garrion Bridge to the boundary with South Lanarkshire on the new Bridge, a distance of 150 metres or thereby.
