Bus Turning Loop on Gainside Road, Glenboig

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2017

On 6 March 2017 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on new cable installation works) on the bus turning loop on Gainside Road, Glenboig from its junction with B804 Glenboig Road over its entire length by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the east side of the closure should proceed eastwards on B804 Glenboig Road then north westwards on Gainside Road to the east of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order which will only be effective when signage is in place, will be operational between 0930 hours and 1530 hours each day, excluding weekends, from 0930 hours on Monday, 20 March 2017 and will remain in operation until 1530 hours on Friday, 31 March 2017.

Bus Turning Loop on Gainside Road, Glenboig

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2017

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Bus Turning loop on Gainside Road, Glenboig) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2017” and shall be effective when signage is in place, will be operational between 0930 hours and 1530 hours each day, excluding weekends, from 0930 hours on Monday, the twentieth day of March, Two thousand and seventeen and will remain in operation until 1530 hours on Friday, the thirty first day of March, Two thousand and seventeen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on new cable installation works) on the bus turning loop on Gainside Road, Glenboig from its junction with B804 Glenboig Road over it's entire length by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the east side of the closure should proceed eastwards on B804 Glenboig Road then north westwards on Gainside Road to the east of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
