Police Report

- 49 calls were made to the police over the last month. In terms of crimes this translated into a few breaches of the peace related to a disturbance outside of the Black Bull; also one assault, 1 cannabis and 1 illegal Valium possession.
- It was noted in discussion that there had been much less trouble from Hatrix which has now ended 18 year old parties.
- Sergeant Black explained changes in the way that police officers would be deployed. All Officers will be part of flexible response and there will be pooling of resources and one sergeant to cover all wards. Sergeant Black said that there would be more information on this soon and he thought that it would mean greater continuity in community policing.
