Police Report

42 calls between 1-20th April which generated 11 crime reports. These included 3 assaults, 2 wasting police time, attempted house breaking, 1 drunk and incapable, 1 drugs possession, 1 firearms offence.

Officers warned of sneak thefts where opportunists let themselves in through unlocked doors and windows. There was a discussion of parking in the Baronhill area which has become increasingly congested and Police Officers undertook to keep an eye on this.

Noted that we have not been able to discover any more about the Lanarkshire Bus Connection Service which excluded Cumbernauld. Agreed that a freedom of information request (FOI) will be sent to the Chief Executive.
