

North Lanarkshire Council
Blairlinn Road, Cumbernauld
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2018

On 5 March 2018 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing) on Blairlinn Road, Cumbernauld from its junction with Towers Road to its junction with Broomlee Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative Routes: Vehicles on the southeast side of the closure wishing to travel to the northwest side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Tower Road, north westwards on Greens Road and Mid Road and north eastwards then south eastwards on Blairlinn Road to the northwest side of the closure.

Vehicles on the northwest side of the closure wishing to travel to the southeast side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

The Order which will only be operational when appropriate signage is in place, will come into operation at 0900 hours on Monday, 19 March 2018 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 30 March 2018.

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Blairlinn Road, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2018” and shall be effective during the period from 0900 hours on Monday, the nineteenth day of March, Two thousand and eighteen until 2359 hours on Friday, the thirtieth day of March, Two thousand and eighteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing) on Blairlinn Road, Cumbernauld from its junction with Towers Road to its junction with Broomlee Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative Routes: Vehicles on the southeast side of the closure wishing to travel to the northwest side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Tower Road, north westwards on Greens Road and Mid Road and north eastwards then south eastwards on Blairlinn Road to the northwest side of the closure.

Vehicles on the northwest side of the closure wishing to travel to the southeast side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
