**Un-named Footpath at Broomlands Road, Cumbernauld**

**(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2018**

On 14 May 2018 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on upgrading of gas pipeline) on unnamed footpath, Broomlands Road, Cumbernauld from a point 34 metres or thereby from the road adjacent to the gable end of 77 Broomlands Road to a point 48 metres or thereby from the road adjacent to the gable end of 77 Broomlands Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the west side of the closure should proceed south westward on footpath 1 (footpath to the rear of no.77 – 67), north westwards on footway 2 and footpath 3 (gable end of no. 135), north eastwards then south eastwards on footpath 4 (footpath to the rear of no. 135-115), north eastwards then south eastwards on footpath 5 then south westwards on footpath 6 to the east side of the closure.*

*Pedestrians on the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

The Order will come into operation at 0900 hours on Wednesday, 30 May 2018 and will remain in operation until 0001 hours on Friday, 22 June 2018.

### Un-named footpath at Broomlands Road, Cumbernauld

#### (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2018

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (un-Named Footpath at Broomlands Road, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2018” and shall be effective during the period from 0900 hours on Wednesday, the thirtieth day of May, Two thousand and eighteen until 0001 hours on Friday, the twenty second day of June, Two thousand and eighteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on upgrading of gas pipeline) on unnamed footpath, Broomlands Road, Cumbernauld from a point 34 metres or thereby from the road adjacent to the gable end of 77 Broomlands Road to a point 48 metres or thereby from the road adjacent to the gable end of 77 Broomlands Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the west side of the closure should proceed south westward on footpath 1 (footpath to the rear of no.77 – 67), north westwards on footway 2 and footpath 3 (gable end of no. 135), north eastwards then south eastwards on footpath 4 (footpath to the rear of no. 135-115), north eastwards then south eastwards on footpath 5 then south westwards on footpath 6 to the east side of the closure.*

*Pedestrians on the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*
