- BK reported that the noticeboard behind Cumbernauld Primary has been damaged again. ALB to inform police.
- BK will discuss alternative with staff at Palacerigg.

Treasurer's Report

- There was no change from the January minute. When the account was last checked (mid Feb) no funds had been received from NLC.
- AM stated that NLC confirmed that payment had been made on 9 February.

Secretary's Report

- We've been contacted by Craig from Community Radio. He's offering to publicise our events or any information we want to highlight.
- We had to ban someone from the facebook page after we received a number of increasingly aggressive messages.
- Had contact from residents worried about what's happening at Auchinbee shops. Various rumours going around but suggestion is that shops are being reallocated, perhaps to burger king? Or Tesco franchises?
- Have also been informed that one of the recycling centres is being closed down. AM confirmed this but we note Westfield centre will remain open

Community Councillors Reports

- CM reported that covers of channels dug for cables by Virgin have lifted in places. She will contact roads dept who will contact Virgin to effect repairs.
- CM reported that drain has now been installed in footpath previously flooded.
- TM reported that paths in Glen Morriston have lifted and not been replaced. She will advise residents to complain to NLC
- BK reported that tree felling was ongoing on the edge of the Community Park. Larch trees which are shallow rooted are being felled as they have reached an age and height when they start to fall over. They are being removed before they become a danger.
- BK reported that tree planting will take place at park in April.
- ALB raised attempted break-ins and it was agreed to add another warning to facebook page.

Councillors Reports

AM reported that Glen Fyne flats will return to fortnightly bin collections. He also noted that West of Scotland Housing Assoc will investigate problems with lights at back of flats.
