SAFETY OF SPORTS GROUNDS - CERTIFICATION ARRANGEMENTS

(1) EXCELSIOR STADIUM, AIRDRIE

2. The Sub-Committee visited and inspected Excelsior Stadium, Airdrie and thereafter considered a report dated 24 May 2011 by the Head of Central Services (1) reminding Members of the previously agreed arrangements for the certification of designated grounds and grounds with regulated stands under the terms of the Safety of Sports Grounds Act 1975 and the Fire Safety and Safety of Places of Sport Act 1987, and (2) advising of outstanding issues in relation to the renewal of the General Safety Certificate for Excelsior Stadium, Airdrie.

Decided: that the General Safety Certificate for Excelsior Stadium, Airdrie be renewed subject to the undernoted being completed by 5 August 2011:-

- (1) the gaps on the double fire doors (Nos. 40 and 53) having the necessary remedial works to be carried out;
- (2) the remainder of the painting work to the stair nosings being completed, and
- (3) any issues arising from the relevant certificates and annual reports which were to be submitted being addressed.

BROADWOOD STADIUM, CUMBERNAULD
