Bishopbriggs Relief Road (Un-named Road)

50 MPH Speed Limit Order 2018

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Bishopbriggs Relief Road (Un-named Road) (50 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2018" and shall come into operation on Monday, the fourth day of June, Two thousand and eighteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding fifty miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule I of this Order.
3. The North Lanarkshire Council (Westerhill Road, Bishopbriggs) (50 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2015 is hereby amended, as detailed in Schedule II to this Order.

SCHEDULE I

50 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Bishopbriggs Relief Road (Un-named Road)

Bishopbriggs Relief Road (Un-named Road) from its junction with Westerhill road at the Wester cleddens Roundabout, northwards to the boundary of East Dunbartonshire Council, a distance of 554 metres or thereby.

SCHEDULE II
ORDER TO BE AMENDED

The North Lanarkshire Council (Westerhill Road, Bishopbriggs) (50 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2015

Delete the following reference in its entirety:-

Westerhill Road, Bisophbriggs from its junction with Wester Cleddens Road which extends from the centre of Wester Cleddens Roundabout, northwards for a distance of 84 metres or thereby.
