A752 Gartcosh Road and A752 Langmuir Road, Bargeddie

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2018

On 4 June 2018 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on the undernoted roads.

A752 Gartcosh Road, Bargeddie from A89/A752 Roundabout to Manse Road

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the west side of the closure should proceed northwards on A752 Gartcosh Road, A752 Cuilhill Road and A752 Gartcosh Road, eastwards on Towhead Road, southwards on Blair Road then westwards on A89 Bank Street, A89 Glasgow Road and A89 Coatbridge Road to the west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed northwards on A752 Gartcosh Road, A752 Cuilhill Road and A752 Gartcosh Road, eastwards on Townhead Road, southwards on Blair Road, westwards on A89 Bank Street, A89 Glasgow Road, A89 Coatbridge Road, south eastwards on A8 Glasgow and Edinburgh Road then northwards on A752 Langmuir Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

A752 Langmuir Road, Bargeddie from A89/A752 Roundabout southwards for a distance of 225 metres or thereby

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the west side of the closure should proceed southwards on A752 Langmuir Road, north westwards on A8 Glasgow and Edinburgh Road then eastwards on A89 Coatbridge Road to the west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the north side of the closure should proceed south on A752 Langmuir Road, north westwards on A8 Glasgow and Edinburgh Road, eastwards on A89 Coatbridge Road, A89 Glasgow Road and A89 Bank Street, northwards on Blair Road, westwards on Townhead Road then southwards on A752 Gartcosh Road, A752 Cuilhill Road and A752 Gartcosh Road to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Saturday, 23 June 2018 and will remain in operation until 0600 hours on Monday, 25 June 2018.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2018

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (A752 Gartcosh Road and Langmuir Road, Bargeddie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2018” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Saturday, the twenty third day, Two thousand and eighteen until 0600 hours on Monday, the twenty fifth, Two thousand and eighteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on the undernoted roads.

A752 Gartcosh Road, Bargeddie from A89/A752 Roundabout to Manse Road

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the west side of the closure should proceed northwards on A752 Gartcosh Road, A752 Cuilhill Road and A752 Gartcosh Road, eastwards on Towhead Road, southwards on Blair Road then westwards on A89 Bank Street, A89 Glasgow Road and A89 Coatbridge Road to the west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed northwards on A752 Gartcosh Road, A752 Cuilhill Road and A752 Gartcosh Road, eastwards on Townhead Road, southwards on Blair Road, westwards on A89 Bank Street, A89 Glasgow Road, A89 Coatbridge Road, south eastwards on A8 Glasgow and Edinburgh Road then northwards on A752 Langmuir Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

A752 Langmuir Road, Bargeddie from A89/A752 Roundabout southwards for a distance of 225 metres or thereby

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the west side of the closure should proceed southwards on A752 Langmuir Road, north westwards on A8 Glasgow and Edinburgh Road then eastwards on A89 Coatbridge Road to the west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the north side of the closure should proceed south on A752 Langmuir Road, north westwards on A8 Glasgow and Edinburgh Road, eastwards on A89 Coatbridge Road, A89 Glasgow Road and A89 Bank Street, northwards on Blair Road, westwards on Townhead Road then southwards on A752 Gartcosh Road, A752 Cuilhill Road and A752 Gartcosh Road to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
