Speed Limit Order 2018

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (A752 Aitkenhead Road, Uddingston and Langmuir Road, Bargeddie) (Speed Limit) Order 2018" and shall come into operation on Saturday, the thirty first day of March, Two thousand and eighteen.

1. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding forty miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule I of this Order.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding thirty miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule II of this Order.

SCHEDULE I

40 MPH SPEED LIMIT

A752 Aitkenhead Road, Uddingston

A752 Aitkenhead Road, Uddingston from the extended line of the northern kerb of Kilmuir Road, north eastwards for a distance of 950 metres or thereby.

SCHEDULE II

30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

A752 Aitkenhead Road, Uddingston

A752 Aitkenhead Road, Uddingston from a point 950 metres or thereby, north of the extended line of the northern kerb of Kilmuir Road, north eastwards and then north westwards to its termination, a distance of 560 metres or thereby.

A752 Langmuir Road, Bargeddie

A752 Langmuir Road, Bargeddie from a point 90 metres or thereby, south east of the extended line of the southern kerb of Rosebank Terrace, southwards to its termination, a distance of 460 metres or thereby.
