Orbiston Road, Bellshill – Film Production

(Temporary Closure) Order 2016

On 23 May 2016 the North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 62 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, made the above-named Order, to be observed by vehicles on Orbiston Road, Bellshill over its entire length.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed south westwards on B7070 Hamilton Road, proceed around the roundabout, exit and proceed south eastwards on Farmgate Square and then north eastwards on Crofthead Crescent to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Tuesday, 7 June 2016 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Wednesday, 8 June 2016.

On 23 May 2016 the North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 62 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Orbiston Road, Bellshill – Film Production) (Temporary Closure) Order 2016” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Tuesday, the seventh day of June, Two thousand and sixteen until 2359 hours on Wednesday, the eighth day of June, Two thousand and sixteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle on Orbiston Road, Bellshill over its entire length.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed south westwards on B7070 Hamilton Road, proceed around the roundabout, exit and proceed south eastwards on Farmgate Square and then north eastwards on Crofthead Crescent to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
