Balcastle Road, Kilsyth

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2016

On 2 May 2016 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on installation of new electricity cable) on Balcastle Road, Kilsyth from the extended line of the southern kerb of Neilston Walk north westwards for a distance of 100 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the southeast side of the closure wishing to travel to the northwest side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Balcastle Road, north eastwards on Glasgow Road, south eastwards on Gateside Avenue, south westwards on A803 Glasgow Road and A803 Kilsyth Road, north westwards then eastwards on Whin Loan then south eastwards on Balcastle Road to the northwest side of the closure.

Vehicles on the northwest side of the closure wishing to travel to the southeast side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Wednesday, 18 May 2016 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Saturday, 28 May 2016.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2016

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Balcastle Road, Kilsyth) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2016” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Wednesday, the eighteenth day of May, Two thousand and sixteen until 2359 hours on Saturday the twenty eighth day of May, Two thousand and sixteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on installation of new electricity cable) on Balcastle Road, Kilsyth from the extended line of the southern kerb of Neilston Walk north westwards for a distance of 100 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the southeast side of the closure wishing to travel to the northwest side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Balcastle Road, north eastwards on Glasgow Road, south eastwards on Gateside Avenue, south westwards on A803 Glasgow Road and A803 Kilsyth Road, north westwards then eastwards on Whin Loan then south eastwards on Balcastle Road to the northwest side of the closure.
