Hulks Road, Airdrie

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2016

On 20 June 2016 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge maintenance works) on Hulks Road, Airdrie from the extended line of the eastern kerb of Muirhead Farm Access Road to the extended line of the western kerb of Brackenknowe Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to travel to the north east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Hulks Road, southwards on B8039 Stirling Road and A73 Stirling Road, north eastwards on B803 Greengairs Road, north westwards on Loanhead Road then south westwards on Hulks Road to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to travel to the south west side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on Hulks Road, south eastwards on Loanhead Road, south westwards on B803 Greengairs Road, northwards on A73 Stirling Road, westwards on B8039 Blackbog Road, northwards on B8039 Stirling Road and north eastwards on Hulks Road to the west side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 4 July 2016 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 11 September 2016.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2016

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Hulks Road, Airdrie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2016” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the fourth day of July, Two thousand and sixteen until 2359 hours on Sunday, the eleventh day of September, Two thousand and sixteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge maintenance works) on Hulks Road, Airdrie from the extended line of the eastern kerb of Muirhead Farm Access Road to the extended line of the western kerb of Brackenknowe Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to travel to the north east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Hulks Road, southwards on B8039 Stirling Road and A73 Stirling Road, north eastwards on B803 Greengairs Road, north westwards on Loanhead Road then south westwards on Hulks Road to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to travel to the south west side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on Hulks Road, south eastwards on Loanhead Road, south westwards on B803 Greengairs Road, northwards on A73 Stirling Road, westwards on B8039 Blackbog Road, northwards on B8039 Stirling Road and north eastwards on Hulks Road to the west side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
