Hartwood Road, Hartwood

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2016

On 28 March 2016, the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Network Rail bridge parapet works) on Hartwood Road, Hartwood from the extended line of the eastern kerb of the entrance to Hartwood Station car park north eastwards and northwards for a distance of 130 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to travel to the south west side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on Hartwood Road, northwards then north eastwards on Newmill and Canthill Road, south eastwards on Shottskirk Road, eastwards then southwards on Station Road, south westwards on B717 Burnbrae Road and on A71 Allanton Road, westwards on Allanton Road then north eastwards on Hartwood Road to the south west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to travel to the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order, which will only be effective when signage is displayed, will come into operation at 2100 hours on Saturday, 9 April 2016 and will remain in operation until 0700 hours on Tuesday, 10 May 2016.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2016

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Hartwood Road, Hartwood) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2016” and shall be effective during the period from 2100 hours on Saturday, the ninth day of April, Two thousand and sixteen until 0700 hours on Tuesday, the tenth day of May, Two thousand and sixteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Network Rail bridge parapet works) on Hartwood Road, Hartwood from the extended line of the eastern kerb of the entrance to Hartwood Station car park north eastwards and northwards for a distance of 130 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to travel to the south west side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on Hartwood Road, northwards then north eastwards on Newmill and Canthill Road, south eastwards on Shottskirk Road, eastwards then southwards on Station Road, south westwards on B717 Burnbrae Road and on A71 Allanton Road, westwards on Allanton Road then north eastwards on Hartwood Road to the south west side of the closure.
