

North Lanarkshire Council
Hagmill Road, Coatbridge
(Temporary Closure) Order 2016

On 4 July 2016 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on M8/M73/M74 Improvement Works) on Hagmill Road, Coatbridge from the extended line of the south western kerb of Dunnotar Avenue, north westwards to its junction with A725 Whifflet Street and North Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north west side of the closure wishing to travel to the south east side of the closure should proceed northwards on A725 Whifflet Street, north eastwards on Calder Street, south eastwards on Garturk Street, north eastwards on Bute Street, south eastwards on Carfin Street, south westwards on Calder Avenue, southwards on Howes Street, westwards on Burleigh Street, southwards on Blackness Street and Berwick Street, westwards on Neidpath Avenue, southwards on Tweed Street and eastwards then southwards on Dunottar Avenue to the south east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south east side of the closure wishing to travel to the north west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Friday, 22 July 2016 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 2 September 2016.

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Hagmill Road, Coatbridge) (Temporary Closure) Order 2016” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Friday, the twenty-second day of July, Two thousand and sixteen until 2359 hours on Friday, the second day of September, Two thousand and sixteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on M8/M73/M74 Improvement Works) on Hagmill Road, Coatbridge from the extended line of the south western kerb of Dunnotar Avenue, north westwards to its junction with A725 Whifflet Street and North Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north west side of the closure wishing to travel to the south east side of the closure should proceed northwards on A725 Whifflet Street, north eastwards on Calder Street, south eastwards on Garturk Street, north eastwards on Bute Street, south eastwards on Carfin Street, south westwards on Calder Avenue, southwards on Howes Street, westwards on Burleigh Street, southwards on Blackness Street and Berwick Street, westwards on Neidpath Avenue, southwards on Tweed Street and eastwards then southwards on Dunottar Avenue to the south east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south east side of the closure wishing to travel to the north west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
