

North Lanarkshire Council
Glenacre Road, Cumbernauld
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2018

On 27 August 2018 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing) on Glenacre Road, Cumbernauld over its entire length by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: There are no alternative routes.

Residents will be able to park their vehicles outwith the hours of 0830 and 1700 each day.

The Order will come into operation at 0900 hours on Monday, 10 September 2018 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 16 September 2018.

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Glenacre Road, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2018” and shall be effective during the period from 0900 hours on Monday, the tenth day of September, Two thousand and eighteen until 2359 hours on Sunday, the sixteenth day of September, Two thousand and eighteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing) on Glenacre Road, Cumbernauld over its entire length by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: There are no alternative routes.

Residents will be able to park their vehicles outwith the hours of 0830 and 1700 each day.
