B802 Auchinstarry Road, Kilsyth
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2018

On 1 October 2018 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway repairs and drainage works and street furniture renewal) on Auchinstarry Road, Kilsyth from Blackwood East Roundabout to its junction with Constarry Road, Kilsyth by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed south east on Constarry Road, south on Eastfield Road and northwest on B8048 Kirkintilloch Road.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicular access will be maintained, to residential properties, during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0800 hours on Monday, 15 October 2018 and will remain in operation until 1800 hours on Friday, 26 October 2018.

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (B802 Auchinstarry Road, Kilsyth) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2018” and shall be effective during the period from 0800 hours on Monday, the fifteenth day of October, Two thousand and eighteen until 1800 hours on Friday, the twenty-sixth day of October, Two thousand and eighteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway repairs and drainage works and street furniture renewal) on Auchinstarry Road, Kilsyth from Blackwood East Roundabout to its junction with Constarry Road, Kilsyth by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed south east on Constarry Road, south on Eastfield Road and northwest on B8048 Kirkintilloch Road.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicular access will be maintained, to residential properties, during the closure.
