B718 Westcraigs Road, Harthill
(Temporary Closure) Order 2018

On 19 November 2018 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge and carriageway maintenance works) on B718 Westcraigs Road, Harthill from the extended north kerbline of Whyte Street, northwards for a distance of 800 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed northwards on B718 Harthill Road, eastwards on A89, southwards on B8084, southwards on A706, westwards on B7066 and northwards on B718 Westcraigs Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Tuesday, 4 December 2018 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 14 December 2018.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2018

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (B718 Westcraigs Road, Harthill) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2018” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Tuesday, the fourth day of December, Two thousand and eighteen until 2359 hours on Friday, the fourteenth day of December, Two thousand and eighteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge and carriageway maintenance works) on B718 Westcraigs Road, Harthill from the extended north kerbline of Whyte Street, northwards for a distance of 800 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed northwards on B718 Harthill Road, eastwards on A89, southwards on B8084, southwards on A706, westwards on B7066 and northwards on B718 Westcraigs Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
