Matters arising	<p>Scottish Water CC acknowledged that all work was completed 3 weeks ahead of schedule with minimum disruption.</p> <p>Play Area Equipment On-going - H McVey is awaiting Play Services suggesting possible dates for a public meeting</p> <p>Speeding Traffic at Kelvinhead On-going. Several suggested solutions to traffic calming by members of the public via Facebook . All were discussed at the CC meeting and J Jones to take forward issues with the Roads department.</p> <p>Posting CC Minutes on Facebook It was proposed by W Hoyle and agreed by all CC members that the Minutes for the CC should not be posted on Facebook. There were discussions regarding re-establishing CC website and also the possibility of setting up a CC Facebook page. George Frew volunteered to look into setting up a CC Facebook page and also to see what would be required to update website.</p> <p>Bin Issues Pamela McLeod confirmed that the Hall Committee paid via direct debit to have their bins emptied and that there were issues with regular pick-ups. She also advised that, at times, the bins have been used by members of the public inappropriately eg. She has found brake pads and tyres in them.</p> <p>Buses W Hoyle advised that she had been approached by members of the public complaining that timetabled buses were not turning up. In response W Hoyle has tried to contact Eastern Central Bus Co by phone but hasn't been successful. It was agreed that, on</p>

Pamela McLeod – Proposed – D Gray Seconded J McKelvie</p> <p>G McGinty - Proposed: W Hoyle Seconded: A Ferrie</p> <p>Pavement Resurfacing Main road into the village will be closed 9.30 – 6pm from 3rd – 7th Dec to allow pavement resurfacing and maintenance. Access to village will be via back road. Concerns were discussed regarding suitability of this road for large vehicles eg buses etc. J Jones will contact the Roads department regarding these concerns.</p> <p>Wreath Laying W Hoyle agreed to ask M Richarson has the wreath.
