SAFETY OF SPORTS GROUNDS - CERTIFICATION ARRANGEMENTS

(1) BROADWOOD STADIUM, CUMBERNAULD

2. The Sub-Committee visited and inspected Broadwood Stadium, Cumbernauld and thereafter considered a report dated 28 May 2013 by the Head of Central Services (1) reminding Members of the previously agreed arrangements for the certification of designated grounds and grounds with regulated stands under the terms of the Safety of Sports Grounds Act 1975 and the Fire Safety and Safety of Places of Sport Act 1987, and (2) advising of outstanding issues in relation to the renewal of the General Safety Certificate for Broadwood Stadium, Cumbernauld.

Decided: that the General Safety Certificate for Broadwood Stadium, Cumbernauld be renewed subject to confirmation being received that the undernoted has been completed by 3 August 2013:-

- (1) the relevant certificates are submitted and any issues arising from the submission of the relevant certificates and annual reports addressed;
- (2) any heavily corroded/unsafe seats in any of the stands should be replaced/repared or put out of use, and
- (3) appropriate remedial action should be taken due to extensive corrosion to the spiral fire escape stair and the north elevation of the gymnasium academy.

(2) CLIFTONHILL STADIUM, COATBRIDGE
