

North Lanarkshire Council
Rochsolloch Road, Airdrie
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2018

On 29 October 2018 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas main renewal works) on Rochsolloch Road, Airdrie from a point 59 metres south of the extended south kerb line of A89 Deedes Street, southwards for a distance of 20 metres or thereby, to the extended north kerb line of Kippen Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on Rochsolloch Road at the north side of the closure wishing to travel to Rochsolloch Road at the south side of the closure should travel generally northwards on Rochsolloch Road, eastwards on A89 Deedes Street, A89 Alexander Street, A89 Weavers Road, southwards on Gartlea Road, westwards on Hogg Street, northwards on B802 Cairnhill Road, westwards on Victoria Place and north westwards on Rochsolloch Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on Rochsolloch Road at the south side of the closure wishing to travel to Rochsolloch Road at the north side of the closure should travel generally south eastwards on Rochsolloch Road, eastwards on Victoria Place, southwards on B802 Cairnhill Road, eastwards on Hogg Street, northwards on Gartlea Road, westwards on A89 Weavers Road, A89 Alexander Street, A89 Deedes Street and southwards on Rochsolloch Road, to the north side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

No vehicular access will be permitted during the closure (including emergency service vehicles).

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Saturday, 17 November 2018 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 25 November 2018.

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Rochsolloch Road, Airdrie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2018” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Saturday, seventeenth day of November, Two thousand and eighteen until 2359 hours on Sunday, twenty fifth day of November, Two thousand and eighteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas main renewal works) on Rochsolloch Road, Airdrie from a point 59 metres south of the extended south kerb line of A89 Deedes Street, southwards for a distance of 20 metres or thereby, to the extended north kerb line of Kippen Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on Rochsolloch Road at the north side of the closure wishing to travel to Rochsolloch Road at the south side of the closure should travel generally northwards on Rochsolloch Road, eastwards on A89 Deedes Street, A89 Alexander Street, A89 Weavers Road, southwards on Gartlea Road, westwards on Hogg Street, northwards on B802 Cairnhill Road, westwards on Victoria Place and north westwards on Rochsolloch Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on Rochsolloch Road at the south side of the closure wishing to travel to Rochsolloch Road at the north side of the closure should travel generally south eastwards on Rochsolloch Road, eastwards on Victoria Place, southwards on B802 Cairnhill Road, eastwards on Hogg Street, northwards on Gartlea Road, westwards on A89 Weavers Road, A89 Alexander Street, A89 Deedes Street and southwards on Rochsolloch Road, to the north side of the closure.
