

North Lanarkshire Council
Main Street, Glenboig
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2019

On 21 January 2019 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas main replacement works) on Main Street, Glenboig from Glenboig New Road to a point 80 metres northwest of its junction with New Road, Glenboig or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed on B804 Main Street, Glenboig Road and Johnston Road, A752 Lochend Road, Coatbridge Road, Gartcosh Road, Cuihill Road and Gartcosh Road, A89 Coatbridge Road, Glasgow Road, Bank Street and South Circular Road, B804 Main Street and Dunbeth Road, B803 Sunnyside Road, B804 Coltswood Road, Gartliston Road and Coatbridge Road.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation at 0100 hours on Thursday, 14 February 2019 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Thursday, 14 March 2019.

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Main Street, Glenboig) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2019” and shall be effective during the period from 0100 hours on Thursday, the fourteenth day of February, Two thousand and nineteen until 2359 hours on Thursday, the fourteenth day of March, Two thousand and nineteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas main replacement works) on Main Street, Glenboig from Glenboig New Road to a point 80 metres northwest of its junction with New Road, Glenboig or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed on B804 Main Street, Glenboig Road and Johnston Road, A752 Lochend Road, Coatbridge Road, Gartcosh Road, Cuihill Road and Gartcosh Road, A89 Coatbridge Road, Glasgow Road, Bank Street and South Circular Road, B804 Main Street and Dunbeth Road, B803 Sunnyside Road, B804 Coltswood Road, Gartliston Road and Coatbridge Road.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
