

The North Lanarkshire Council
(A73 Stirling Road, Stand, Airdrie)
(40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2004

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (A73 Stirling Road, Stand, Airdrie) (40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2004" and shall come into operation on Wednesday, the eighteenth day of August, Two thousand and four.
2. In this Order the following expression has the meaning hereby assigned to it:

"vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power";
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

40 MPH Speed Limit

Length of road within
North Lanarkshire

1. That length of A73 Stirling Road, Stand, Airdrie, from a point 25 metres north of the extended north kerblineline of B803 Raebog Road, northwards to a point 38 metres south of the extended south kerblineline of B803 Greengairs Road, a distance of 865 metres or thereby.
