

ROADS (SCOTLAND) ACT 1984

The North Lanarkshire Council (Watt Street, Airdrie) (Stopping Up) Order 2005

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 68(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having considered that the road specified in the Schedule to this Order has become unnecessary and being satisfied that no alternative road is necessary, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the North Lanarkshire Council (Watt Street, Airdrie) (Stopping Up) Order 2005 and shall come into operation on Monday, the seventeenth day of January, Two thousand and five.
2. The stopping up of the road in the town of Airdrie specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby ordered.
3. Where there is, immediately before the date on which the said road is stopped up under this Order, any apparatus belonging to any statutory undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across that length of road for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking the said statutory undertakers shall after commencement of this Order continue to have all rights in respect of the said apparatus as they had immediately before that date.
