(COLTNESS AND ST. AIDAN'S PRIMARY SCHOOLS, COLTNESS ROAD, WISHAW)

(20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2004

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Coltness and St. Aidan's Primary Schools, Coltness Road, Wishaw) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2004" and shall come into operation on Monday, the seventh day of February, Two thousand and five.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on Coltness Road, Wishaw from a point 8 metres north of the extended line of the north kerb of Mission Gardens at its junction with Coltness Road to a point 145 metres north of the extended line of the north kerb of Till Street at its junction with Coltness Road, a distance of 297 metres or thereby.
3. This Order will only be in force when the speed limit signs are activated.
