**(20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Sikeside and St. Stephen's Primary Schools, Sikeside Street, Coatbridge) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005 and shall come into operation on Monday the twenty eighth day of March 2005.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on Sikeside Street, Coatbridge from a point 6 metres north of the extended line of the north kerb of Shiel Place at its junction with Sikeside Street to a point 32 metres north of the extended line of the north kerb of the unnamed access to number 45 to 49 Sikeside Street, a distance of 195 metres or thereby.
3. This Order will only be in force when the speed limit signs are activated.
