(St.Maurices High School, North Road and Westfield Road, Cumbernauld)

(20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (St.Maurices High School, North Road and Westfield Road, Cumbernauld) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005" and shall come into operation on Monday the fourth day of April 2005.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. This order will only be in force when the speed limit signs are activated.

SCHEDULE I

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Length(s) of road in the region of North Lanarkshire

B802 North Road, Cumbernauld

The length of North Road from the extended line of the south kerb of Westfield Road, southwards for a distance of 301 metres or thereby.

Westfield Road, Cumbernauld

The length of Westfield Road from a point 100 metres west of the extended line of the west kerb of B802 North Road, eastwards to a point 100 metres east of the extended line of the east kerb of B802 North Road, a distance of 215 metres or thereby.
