(Waverley Drive, Wishaw)

(Weight Restriction) Order 2005

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Waverley Drive, Wishaw) (Weight Restriction) Order 2005" and shall come into operation on Monday the fourth day of April 2005.
- 2.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle in excess of 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this order with the exception of:
 - (a) Gritting vehicles actively gritting.
 - (b) Maintenance vehicles involved in carrying out works on this section of road.
 - (c) Emergency Service's Vehicles.
 - (d) Refuse vehicles.
3. The Strathclyde Regional Council (Waverley Drive, Wishaw) (Weight Restriction) Order 1982 will be revoked as part of this order.

Weight Restriction

Lengths of roads in North Lanarkshire within the Wishaw Area
