(CLARKSTON PRIMARY SCHOOL, A89 FORREST STREET, AIRDRIE)

(20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Clarkston Primary School, A89 Forrest Street, Airdrie) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005" and shall come into operation on the twenty fifth day of April 2005.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this order.
3. This order will only be in force when the speed limit signs are activated.
