**(20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2004**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (St. Andrews and Cumbernauld Primary Schools, Eastfield Road, Cumbernauld) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2004" and shall come into operation on Tuesday the third day of May 2005.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this order.
3. This Order will only be in force when the speed limit signs are activated.

Length(s) of Road in the region of North Lanarkshire

The length of Eastfield Road, Cumbernauld from a point 176 metres west of the extended line of the east kerb of the access road to St. Andrews and Cumbernauld Primary Schools, eastwards to a point 140 metres east of the extended line of the east kerb of the access to St. Andrews and Cumbernauld Primary Schools, a distance of 316 metres or thereby.
