(20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (St. Francis Primary School and Westfield Primary School, Westfield Drive, Cumbernauld) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005" and shall come into operation on Tuesday, the third day of May, two thousand and five.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. This Order will only be in force when the speed limit signs are activated.

SCHEDULE I

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Length(s) of road in the region of North Lanarkshire

Westfield Drive, Cumbernauld

The length of Westfield Drive from a point 16 metres east of the extended line of the east kerb of Tomtain Brae, east, south and westwards to a point 57 metres southwest of the extended line of the west kerb of Inchwood Road, a distance of 436 metres or thereby.
