**(20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Mossend & Holy Family Primary Schools, Calder Road, Clydesdale Road & Hope Street, Mossend) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005" and shall come into operation on Monday, the twenty-seventh day of June, two thousand and five.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. This Order will only be in force when the speed limit signs are activated.

**SCHEDULE I**

**20 MPH SPEED LIMIT**

Length(s) of road in the region of North Lanarkshire

Calder Road, Mossend

The length of Calder Road from a point 74 metres north of the extended north kerbline of Hope Street southwards to a point 42 metres south of the extended south kerbline of Clyde Drive, a distance of 472 metres or thereby.

Clydesdale Road, Mossend

The length of Clydesdale Road from Calder Road eastwards to a point 47 metres east of the extended east kerbline of Christie Street, a distance of 224 metres or thereby.

Hope Street, Mossend

The length of Hope Street from Calder Road westwards and northwards to its termination, a distance of 193 metres or thereby.
