
(Cleland Primary School, B7029 Main Street, Cleland)

(20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Cleland Primary School, B7029 Main Street, Cleland) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005" and shall come into operation on Monday the eighteenth day of July, two thousand and five.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. This order will only be in force when the speed limit signs are activated.

SCHEDULE I

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Length(s) of road in the region of North Lanarkshire

B7029 Main Street

The length of B7029 Main Street from a point 16 metres north-east of the extended kerbline of Carey Gardens south-westwards to a point 8 metres north-east of the extended north-east kerbline of the access to units 2 to 8 Main Street, a distance of 108 metres or thereby.
