
(Dewar Road, Stepps)

(40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Dewar Road, Stepps) (40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005" and shall come into operation on Monday, the first day of August, two thousand and five.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding forty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in Schedule I to this Order.

SCHEDULE I

40 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Dewar Road, Stepps (off Crow Wood Roundabout)

The length of Dewar Road from a point 113 metres north of the extended south kerb line of Kilpatrick Drive, northwards to a point 11 metres south of the extended south kerb line of the south side footway west of Crow Wood roundabout on Cumbernauld Road, a distance of 665 metres or thereby.
