**(ST DOMINIC'S, PETERSBURN & DUNROBIN PRIMARY SCHOOLS AND
CALDERVALE HIGH SCHOOL, AIRDRIE)**

(20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2005

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (St Dominic's, Petersburn & Dunrobin Primary Schools & Caldervale High School, Airdrie) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005" and shall come into operation on Monday, the nineteenth day of December, two thousand and five.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. This Order will only be in force when the speed limit signs are activated.

SCHEDULE I

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Length(s) of road in the region of North Lanarkshire

Petersburn Road, Airdrie

The length of Petersburn Road, Airdrie from a point 21 metres south-west of the extended line of the south-west kerblines of Varnsdorf Way south-westwards for a distance of 210 metres or thereby.

Petersburn Road, Airdrie

The length of Petersburn Road, Airdrie from a point 15 metres south-west of the extended line of the south-west kerb of Glen Road north-eastwards for a distance of 205 metres or thereby.

Glen Road, Airdrie

The length of Glen Road, Airdrie from its junction with Petersburn Road south-eastwards to a point 12 metres north-west of the extended line of the north kerblines of Glendale Avenue for a distance of 93 metres or thereby.

Towers Road, Airdrie

The length of Towers Road, Airdrie from a point 10 metres south-east of the extended line of the south kerb of Petersburn Road south-eastwards to a point 25 metres south-east of the extended line of the south kerb of Varnsdorf Way, a distance of 300 metres or thereby.
