

North Lanarkshire Council
(Various Schools, Central Area)
(20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Various Schools, Central Area) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005" and shall come into operation on the third day of April, two thousand and six.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. This Order will only be in force when the speed limit signs are activated.

SCHEDULE I

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Length(s) of road in the region of North Lanarkshire

New Monkland Primary School, Glenmavis

B803 Raebog Road, Glenmavis

The length of B803 Raebog Road from a point 57 metres south-west of the extended south-west kerb line of Appin Way westwards for a distance of 112 metres or thereby.

Chapelside Primary School, Airdrie

Chapel Street, Airdrie

The length of Chapel Street from a point 10 metres south-west of the extended south-west kerb line of Anderson Lane north-eastwards to a point 23 metres east of the extended east kerb line of Mill Road, a distance of 219 metres or thereby.

Wellington Street, Airdrie

The entire length of Wellington Street from its junction with Chapel Street north-westwards to its termination, a distance of 124 metres or thereby.

St. Kevin's Primary School, Bargeddie

A752 Langmuir Road, Bargeddie

The length of the A752 Langmuir Road from a point 35 metres south of the extended south kerb line of Rosebank Terrace northwards and north-westwards to a point 54 metres south-east of the extended south-east kerb line of Dykehead Road, a distance of 312 metres or thereby.

Rosebank Terrace, Bargeddie

The length of Rosebank Terrace from its junction with Langmuir Road westwards to a point 32 metres east of the extended east kerb line of Monklands View Crescent, a distance of 45 metres or thereby.
