(30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (B819, Lindsaybeg Road, Chryston) (30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2006" and shall come into operation on Monday, the twenty seventh day of March, two thousand and six.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding thirty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE I

30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Length(s) of road in the region of North Lanarkshire

B819 Lindsaybeg Road, Chryston

The length of B819 Lindsaybeg Road from a point 30 metres north of the centre line of its junction with Main Street, Chryston north westwards to a point 45 metres west of the extended line of the west kerb of Peathill Avenue, a distance of 500 metres or thereby.
