(Clyde Valley High School and Overtown Primary School, Overtown)

(20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Clyde Valley High School and Overtown Primary School, Overtown) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2006" and shall come into operation on Monday the twentieth day of March 2006.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. This Order will only be in force when the speed limit signs are activated.

Schedule 1

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Lengths of road in the region of North Lanarkshire

Clyde Valley High School, B754 Castlehill Road, Overtown

The length of B754 Castlehill Road from a point 19 metres north-west of the extended line of the north-east kerblineline of Orchard Street north-westwards to a point 105 metres north-west of the extended south-east kerblineline of the north-west vehicular access into Clyde Valley High School, a distance of 330 metres or thereby.

Overtown Primary School, A71 Main Street, Overtown

The length of A71 Main Street from a point 44 metres north of the extended line of the north gable wall of Overtown Primary School southwards to a point 5 metres north of the extended line of the north gable wall of number 21 Main Street, Overtown a distance of 150 metres or thereby.
