**(Glencairn Primary School and Cathedral Primary School, Motherwell)**

**(20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2006**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Glencairn Primary School and Cathedral Primary School, Motherwell) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2006" and shall come into operation on Monday the twentieth day of March 2006.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. This Order will only be in force when the speed limit signs are activated.

Schedule 1

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Lengths of road in the region of North Lanarkshire

Glencairn Primary School, Glencairn Street and Camp Street, Motherwell

The length of Glencairn Street from a point 22 metres north-west of the extended line of the north-west kerb of School View south-eastwards to a point 45 metres south-east of the extended line of the south-east kerb of Camp Street, a distance of 208 metres or thereby.

The length of Camp Street from a point 33 metres north-east of the extended line of the north-east kerb of Glencairn Street south-westwards to a point 92.5 metres south-west of the extended line of the south-west kerb of Glencairn Street, a distance of 130 metres or thereby.

Cathedral Primary School, Scott Street, Coursington Road and Park Street, Motherwell

The length of Scott Street from a point 79.5 metres south-west of the extended line of the south-west kerb of Dalziel Street south-westwards to the extended line of the south-west kerb of Park Street, a distance of 123 metres or thereby.

The length of Coursington Road from its junction with Park Street north-eastwards for a distance of 134 metres or thereby.

The length of Park Street from the extended line of the north-west kerb of Scott Street south-eastwards to a point 55 metres south-east of the extended line of the south-east kerb of Coursington Road, a distance of 153 metres or thereby.
