

North Lanarkshire Council
(Chryston High School, Chryston)
(20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Chryston High School, Chryston) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005" and shall come into operation on Monday the third day of April, two thousand and six.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding twenty miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. This Order will only be in force when the speed limit signs are activated.

SCHEDULE I

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Length(s) of road in the region of North Lanarkshire

Chryston High School, Chryston

B819 Lindsaybeg Road, Chryston

The length of B819 Lindsaybeg Road from a point 7 metres north of the line of the extended north kerb of Cloverhill Place northwards to a point 43 metres north of the line of the extended north kerb of Main Street, a distance of 193 metres or thereby.
