(Temporary No Waiting and No Loading Restrictions) Order 2019

On 15 April 2019 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait or load (with the exception of vehicles engaged on crane access works) on the undernoted road.

No Waiting and No Loading at Any Times

Lengths of Road in the Region of North Lanarkshire	Side of Road to Which Restriction Applies
Woodside Drive, Calderbank - from its junction with Crowwood Road westwards to its termination	South

The Order, which continues the restrictions currently in place by virtue of a similar Order made by the Council on Monday, 18 September 2018, will only be in place between 0930 hours and 1900 hours each day, will come into operation at 1900 hours on Tuesday, 30 April 2019 and will remain in operation until 1900 hours on Friday, 1 November 2019.

(Temporary No Waiting and No Loading Restrictions) Order 2019

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Woodside Drive, Calderbank) (Temporary No Waiting and No Loading Restrictions) Order 2019” and continues the restrictions currently in place by virtue of a similar Order made by the Council on Monday, the eighteenth day of September, Two thousand and eighteen, will only be in place between 0930 hours and 1900 hours each day, shall be effective during the period from 1900 hours on Tuesday, the thirtieth day of April, Two thousand and nineteen until 1900 hours on Friday, the first day of November, Two thousand and nineteen.
2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait or load at any time (with the exception of vehicles engaged on crane access works) on Woodside Drive, Calderbank from its junction with Crowwood Road, westwards to its termination, on the south side of the road.
