- **Matters Arising ;**

-Bank of Scotland has asked for further completion and information to change Bank Details of Cairnhill Community Council, these were actioned tonight after meeting by Michael Mc Bride and Mary Mac Pherson. Mary ( Treasurer will await on update from Bank )

- **Finance :** Mary ( Treasuer), gave a Finance update : Current bank balance is : £2456.83 (approx.), still awaiting on Bank Statements from Bank
- **Visitors :** Police gave an update on local issues , eg from 26<sup>th</sup> March -30<sup>th</sup> April 2019, 134 incidents and 30 Crimes , an example : 4 assaults , 5 RTA , 6 Inquisitive Crimes , 1 BOP , 3 Possible offensive Weapons, 1 wild fire , 10 other. 11 were detected.

- It was noted that Police were visible around Cairnhill, and residents are grateful. And ask that Police continue with visibility around the area Day and Nights. And residents remain vigilant and report anything unusual to call ....101 or 999 in an Emergency.
