(Temporary Prohibition of Right Turn Manoeuvre) Order 2019

On 23 April 2019 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to carry out a right turn manoeuvre (with the exception of vehicles engaged on new sewer connection works) on the undernoted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

From Oakridge Road to A89 Glasgow Road, Bargeddie
From Stewart Drive to A89 Coatbridge Road, Bargeddie
From A89 Glasgow Road to Oakridge Road, Bargeddie
From A89 Coatbridge Road to Stewart Drive, Bargeddie

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order, which will only be effective when signage is in place, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 6 May 2019 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 28 June 2019.

(Temporary Prohibition of Right Turn Manoeuvre) Order 2019

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Glasgow Road, Bargeddie) (Temporary Prohibition of Right Turn Manoeuvre) Order 2019” which will only be effective when appropriate signage is in place, shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the sixth day of May, Two thousand and nineteen until 2359 hours on Friday, the twenty-eighth day of June, Two thousand and nineteen.
2. No person shall be permitted to carry out a right turn manoeuvre (with the exception of vehicles engaged on new sewer connection works) on the undernoted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

From Stewart Drive to A89 Coatbridge Road, Bargeddie
From A89 Glasgow Road to Oakridge Road, Bargeddie
From A89 Coatbridge Road to Stewart Drive, Bargeddie
