Various Streets, Motherwell – Public Procession

(Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2019

On 13 May 2019 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 62 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, is required for the closure and waiting/ loading restrictions listed below in connection with the public procession on 1st June 2019 on the under-noted roads from 0001 hours to 1800 hours on Saturday 1st June 2019.

Road Closures

Avon Street, Motherwell over its entire length.

Cameron Street, Motherwell over its entire length.

A723, Hamilton Road, Motherwell from the junction with Cameron Street to the junction with the A721, Muir Street.

A721, Muir Street, Motherwell from the junction with the A723, Hamilton Road to the junction with Milton Street.

Milton Street, Motherwell from the junction A721, Muir Street to the junction with Woodburn Street.

Woodburn Street, Motherwell over its entire length.

Mill Road, Motherwell from the junction with Woodburn Street to the junction with the A723, Merry Street.

Merry Street, Motherwell A723, Merry Street from the junction with Mill Road to the junction with A721, Muir Street.

Menteith Road, Motherwell from the junction with the A723, Merry Street to the junction with Pollock Street.

Pollock Street, Motherwell from the junction with Mentelth Road to the junction with A723, Merry Street.

(Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2019

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 62 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Various Streets, Motherwell – Public Procession) (Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2019” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours until 1800 hours on Saturday the first day of June, Two thousand and nineteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles being used in connection with the Public Procession on Saturday the first day of June, two thousand and nineteen) on the following roads.

Road Closures

Avon Street, Motherwell over its entire length.

Cameron Street, Motherwell over its entire length.

A723, Hamilton Road, Motherwell from the junction with Cameron Street to the junction with the A721, Muir Street.

A721, Muir Street, Motherwell from the junction with the A723, Hamilton Road to the junction with Milton Street.

Milton Street, Motherwell from the junction A721, Muir Street to the junction with Woodburn Street.

Woodburn Street, Motherwell over its entire length.

Mill Road, Motherwell from the junction with Woodburn Street to the junction with the A723, Merry Street.

Merry Street, Motherwell A723, Merry Street from the junction with Mill Road to the junction with A721, Muir Street.

Menteith Road, Motherwell from the junction with the A723, Merry Street to the junction with Pollock Street.

Pollock Street, Motherwell from the junction with Menteith Road to the junction with A723, Merry Street.
