### Executive Summary

The purpose of this report is two-fold, firstly to provide the Youth, Equalities and Empowerment Committee with details of applications submitted for funding from the Community Grants Scheme during 2018/19 and the awards made, and to provide Committee with additional recommendations for the Grant Awards Programme (2019/20) funding for approval.

The Community Grants Scheme exists to provide small amounts of funding to community and voluntary organisations operating in North Lanarkshire.

The Grant Awards Programme seeks to support community and voluntary organisations' contribution towards achieving outcomes included in the *Plan for North Lanarkshire*.

### Recommendations

It is recommended that the Youth, Equalities and Empowerment Committee:-

- (1) note the details of the awards made through the 2018/19 Community Grants Scheme as listed in Appendices 1 to 7 of this report; and
- (2) approve the additional funding recommendations for the 2019/20 Grant Awards Programme as outlined in Appendix 8 of this report.

## **1. Background**

### **1.1 Funding Allocations – Community Grants Scheme and Grant Awards Programme**

The budget for the Community Grants Scheme for 2018/19 was £189,810, providing an allocation of £2,465 per elected member.

At its meeting on 20 August 2013, the former Learning and Leisure Services Committee approved the arrangements for the introduction of the Grant Awards Programme together with an associated scoring system against which all applications are assessed.

At its meeting on 21<sup>st</sup> February 2019 the Council approved a package of budget reductions which included a reduction in the Grant Awards Programme budget of 20% (£162,169). The budget available to support the 2019/20 programme is £648,678.

## **2. Report**

### **2.1 Community Grants**

The Head of Communities has delegated powers to allocate funding in respect of community grants recommendations once these are completed and, annually, a report is presented to committee detailing all of the awards made through this scheme within the previous financial year.

This report is the seventh such annual report on Community Grant awards. Appendices 1 – 7 detail awards made on an area by area basis plus one for multi-area requests. When an organisation has been in receipt of multiple awards, these have been combined and totalled.

A number of applications, made in the previous financial year, were continued across the financial year end. Where partial awards have been made during 2017/2018 and the remainder awarded in 2018/19, only the element of the award made in 2018/19 has been listed.

### **2.2 Grant Awards Programme**

At its meeting on 21<sup>st</sup> March 2019 the Policy and Strategy Committee approved funding recommendations for the Grant Awards Programme for 53 organisations. At that time a further 18 were pending the submission of further information.

At its meeting on 29<sup>th</sup> April 2019 the Youth, Equalities and Empowerment Committee approved funding recommendations for a further 10 organisations and continuing the decision on one application for further consideration. At that time a further 7 were pending consideration awaiting further information.

This report now sets out funding recommendations for the continued application and the remaining outstanding applications.

As before, applications are split into two categories depending on whether the organisation is currently funded or whether they are a new applicant.

### 2.2.1 Applications from Currently Funded Organisations

In line with previous decisions regarding the Grant Awards Programme, recommendations for existing funded organisations have been made on the following basis:-

- Scores of 1 to 3 – a reduction in their current funding of 22%; and
- Scores of 4 and above – a reduction in their current award of 26%.

Of the 7 additional applications in this category, 4 have scored 1 to 3, 1 have scored 4 or more; 2 have scored 4 or above. One applicant failed to supply the information requested and therefore has been withdrawn from consideration.

#### Continued New Applicant

Consideration of the application from Cool School Uniforms was continued for further consideration. Following a visit to the organisation, additional information was provided. As a result of the provision of this additional information, an award of £1,000 is recommended.

## 3. Equality and Diversity

### 3.1 Fairer Scotland Duty

The grants provided to community and voluntary organisations as part of the Community Grants Programme, support the requirements of the Fairer Scotland Duty.

An integrated Fairer Scotland/Equality Impact assessment on the budget saving option to reduce the funding for the Grant Awards programme was carried out and published on the Council's website. Higher scoring applications as assessed have been prioritised in terms of the funding allocations.

### 3.2 Equality Impact Assessment

Equality Impact Assessment carried out when award criterion originally prepared.

An integrated Fairer Scotland/Equality Impact assessment on the budget saving option to reduce the funding for the Grant Awards programme was carried out and published on the Council's website. Higher scoring applications as assessed have been prioritised in terms of the funding allocations.

## 4. Implications

### 4.1 Financial Impact

#### 4.1.1 Community Grants

The awards detailed in Appendices 1-7 total £186,522, and were paid from the 2018/19 budget of £189,810.

#### 4.1.2 Grant Awards Programme

Details of the additional grant award applications assessed and recommendations totalling £36,723 is listed in Appendix 8.

This will bring the total awarded so far to £635,636 set against a total budget of £648,678.

#### 4.2 HR/Policy/Legislative Impact

#### 4.3 Environmental Impact

Many of the organisations funded via the Community Grants Scheme deliver programmes/services that impact positively on the environments of North Lanarkshire communities.


