Business arising from the minutes

Backcourts Wishaw Main Street

Some discussion took place with several members and Councillor Burgess contributing to the debate. The secretary reported that “fly tipping” has continued around the backcourts of the town centre and the only areas of success were where owners had secured their properties with metal gates. The general opinion of those in attendance was that in the long term securing properties would be cost effective and would reduce “fly tipping” through reducing access to vehicles.
