Victoria Place, Airdrie
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020

On 6 January 2020 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas main works) on Victoria Place, Airdrie from the extended west kerb line of B802 Cairnhill Road, westwards to the extended east kerb line of Woodburn Avenue or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on B802 Cairnhill Road at the east side of the closure wishing to travel to Victoria Place at the west side of the closure, should travel generally southwards on B802 Cairnhill Road, eastwards on Hogg Street, northwards on Gartlea Road, westwards on A89 Weavers Road, Alexander Street, Deedes Street, Main Street, south eastwards on Rochsolloch Road, eastwards on Victoria Place, to the west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the Victoria Place at the west side of the closure wishing to travel to B802 Cairnhill Road at the east side of the closure should travel generally westwards on Victoria Place, north westwards on Rochsolloch Road, eastwards on A89 (Main Street, Deedes Street, Alexander Street, Weavers Road), southwards on Gartlea Road, westwards on Hogg Street, northwards on B802 Cairnhill Road, to the east side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained where practicable, during the closure.

Access to Airdrie Train Station Car Park will be maintained during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 20 January 2020 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 8 March 2020.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Victoria Place, Airdrie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twentieth day of January, Two thousand and twenty until 2359 hours on Sunday, the eighth day of March, Two thousand and twenty.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas main works) on Victoria Place, Airdrie from the extended west kerb line of B802 Cairnhill Road, westwards to the extended east kerb line of Woodburn Avenue or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on B802 Cairnhill Road at the east side of the closure wishing to travel to Victoria Place at the west side of the closure, should travel generally southwards on B802 Cairnhill Road, eastwards on Hogg Street, northwards on Gartlea Road, westwards on A89 Weavers Road, Alexander Street, Deedes Street, Main Street, south eastwards on Rochsolloch Road, eastwards on Victoria Place, to the west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the Victoria Place at the west side of the closure wishing to travel to B802 Cairnhill Road at the east side of the closure should travel generally westwards on Victoria Place, north westwards on Rochsolloch Road, eastwards on A89 (Main Street, Deedes Street, Alexander Street, Weavers Road), southwards on Gartlea Road, westwards on Hogg Street, northwards on B802 Cairnhill Road, to the east side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained where practicable, during the closure.

Access to Airdrie Train Station Car Park will be maintained during the closure.
