

**North Lanarkshire Council**  
**Mill Road, Allanton**  
**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020**

On 20 January 2020 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Scottish Power Upgrade Works) on Mill Road, Allanton from its junction with Coltness Avenue, southwards for a distance of 250 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed eastwards on Coltness Avenue, westwards on A71 Allanton Road, south westwards on A71, south eastwards on Sharnothshield Road and northwards on Mill Road to the south side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 3 February, 2020 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 23 February 2020.

**Mill Road, Allanton**  
**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Mill Road, Allanton) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the third day of February, Two thousand and twenty until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twenty-third day of February, Two thousand and twenty.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Scottish Power Upgrade Works) on Mill Road, Allanton from its junction with Coltness Avenue, southwards for a distance of 250 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed eastwards on Coltness Avenue, westwards on A71 Allanton Road, south westwards on A71, south eastwards on Sharnothshield Road and northwards on Mill Road to the south side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
